

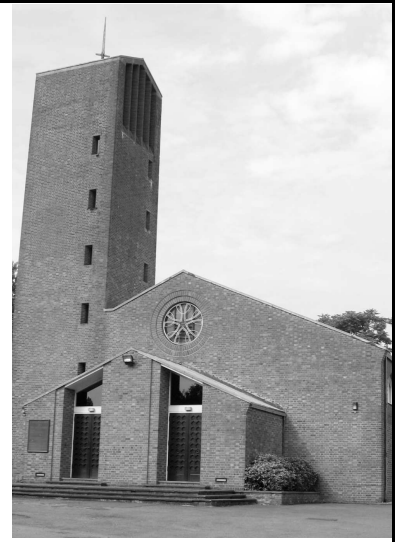

Baptism of the Lord 10th January 2010

Once we are born into the world we get drawn into the life of the people around us. Our Family is the group of people who initiate us into their customs and regulations and respects. As we grow older (not necessarily wiser) and more independent we impress our own ideas and respects. Thus, there arises compromise. With compromise there is possibility for the Family / Group / Community to move in good and supportive ways, holding true to the spirit of its life.

An enlightening compromise is found in today's second Reading, Peter proclaims: "God does not have favourites, but that anybody of any nationality who fears God and does what is right is acceptable to Him." The spirit of this Christian community is to get free from the power of evil. We read in the psalm that God is in control, His power is for ever. No compromise is found in God, He will bless His people with peace.

In the Baptism of Christ is seen the ineffable sanctity of human life, "You are my Son (my daughter/my child)". The Father reaches out to all humanity created by Him. Christ, begotten not created, is intrinsically one with Father and Holy Spirit as God yet, in his humanity He draws us into the spirit of God, Father - Son - Holy Spirit.

In our Baptism we are Baptised into the death of Christ and so into His Resurrection. Through Christ the love of God is not compromised and allows His favour to rest on each one of us.

ST.
